(a) What amounts has her Department paid to the Karate Association Western Cape (KAWC) in (i) 2009/10, (ii) 2010/11, (iii) 2011/12, (iv) 2012/13, (v) 2013/14, (vi) 2014/15, (v) 2015/16, (vi) 2016/17, (vii) 2017/18 and (viii) 2018/19 to date to support athletes from the Western Cape who have achieved their national colours and participated in national and international competitions and/or events and (b) for any expenditure related to the operations of KAWC?

- (3) who were or are the individual beneficiaries of funding in the (i) 2009/10, (ii) 2010/11, (iii) 2011/12, (iv) 2012/13, (v) 2013/14, (vi) 2014/15, (v) 2015/16, (vi) 2016/17, (vii) 2017/18 and (viii) 2018/19 financial years to date?
