**QUESTION FOR WRITTEN REPLY**

**13. Mr R B Lentit to ask Mr A W Bredell, Minister of Local Government, Environmental Affairs and Development Planning:**

Whether all the districts in the Western Cape have disaster management centres; if not, why not; if so, (a) what is the location of each centre in the respective districts, (b) what are the operating challenges and (c) what achievements regarding weather related disasters to assist with emergencies in (i) other districts and (ii) areas outside the boundaries of the Western Cape?

**REPLY:**

All the districts and the City of Cape Town within the Western Cape have disaster management centres, with the most recent centre officially opened for Cape Winelands District Municipality on 6 June 2014. All the District Municipalities share a facility with the Department of Health: Emergency Medical Services which is more cost-efficient and provides the opportunity to streamline response in the district areas.

The districts have well established communication systems in place during weather-related incidents where the increase of rainfall in one district may cause rivers to burst their banks in another district. This communication between districts is a vital achievement and critical when dealing with weather-related incidents.

The Western Cape Disaster Management Centre (WCDMC) is always in a state of readiness and should it be required it can be utilised by any of the other centres as a back-up. The WCDMC also plays a supportive role to the other centres by assisting with coordination during weather related events.

Furthermore the Department of Local Government under the auspices of the Western Cape Disaster Management Centre has entered in a Collaboration Protocol with the neighbouring coastal provinces. The protocol calls for the provinces to materially assist each other and to co-ordinate the provision of services in their respective areas. It is envisaged that this protocol be adapted for the utilisation at a district level sphere.

#### **13.Mnr R B Lentit vra Mnr A W Bredell, Minister van Plaaslike Regering, Omgewingsake en Ontwikkelingsbeplanning:**

Of al die distrikte in die Wes-Kaap rampbestuursentrums het; indien nie, waarom nie; indien wel, (a) wat is die ligging van elke sentrum in die onderskeie distrikte, (b) wat is die bedryfsuitdagings en (c) watter prestasies met betrekking tot weerverwante rampe is bereik om bystand in noodtoestande in (i) ander distrikte en (ii) gebiede buite die grense van die Wes-Kaap te verleen?

#### **ANTWOORD:**

In die Wes-Kaap het al die distrikte en die Stad Kaapstad rampbestuursentrums. Die jongste sentrum is amptelik op 6 Junie 2014 in die Kaapse Wynland-distriksmunisipaliteit geopen. Die distriksmunisipaliteite deel almal 'n fasiliteit met die Departement van Gesondheid: Nood- Mediese Dienste, wat meer kostedoeltreffend is en die geleentheid bied om reaksie in die distriksgebiede vaartbelyn te maak.

Die distrikte het goed gevestigde kommunikasiestelsels gereed tydens weerverwante voorvalle waar 'n toename in reënval in een distrik kan veroorsaak dat riviere in 'n ander distrik hulle walle oorstrom. Hierdie kommunikasie tussen distrikte is 'n belangrike kritieke prestasie vir die hantering van weerverwante voorvalle.

Die Wes-Kaapse Rampbestuursentrum (WKRBS) is altyd in 'n staat van gereedheid en kan deur enige van die ander sentrums as rugsteun gebruik word as dit nodig sou wees. Die WKRBS speel ook 'n ondersteunende rol vir die ander sentrums deur met koördinering tydens weerverwante voorvalle te help.

Verder het die Departement van Plaaslike Regering, onder beskerming van die Wes-Kaapse Rampbestuursentrum, 'n samewerkingsprotokol met die naburige kusprovinsies aangegaan. Die protokol bepaal dat die provinsies mekaar daadwerklik moet help en die verskaffing van dienste in hulle gebiede moet koördineer. Daar word in die vooruitsig gestel dat hierdie protokol vir gebruik op distriksvlak aangepas kan word.
