1. Welcome

The Chairperson welcomed all and allowed for brief introductions. He set the context for the meeting which was to discuss Vote 4: Community Safety in the Schedule to the Western Cape Appropriations Bill [B2-2022]. The delegation was led by Ms A Marais, the Acting Minister, Adv Y Pillay as departmental head, and Mr S George, as the Chief Executive Officer of the Western Cape Liquor Authority (WCLA).

2. Deliberations

The Chairperson tabled Vote 4: Community Safety in the Schedule to the Western Cape Appropriations Bill [B2-2022] and the Department duly responded to the Committee's questions. The Committee also addressed the budgetary matters related to the (WCLA).

3. Public participation

The Chairperson invited public participation. There was no input given prior or during the meeting.

The Chairperson thanked the Acting Minister, the Department and the WCLA for their participation and excused them from the meeting.

- 5.4. A copy of the Transversal Security Provision Framework Agreement for the 2022/2023 financial vear.
- 5.5. A copy of the investigation report into funding allocated to Laingsburg Municipality for the purposes of safety and security in that region. Where applicable, also indicate the mechanisms that the Department uses to monitor how recipient municipalities spend funding allocated for the purposes of safety and security.
- 5.6. A copy of /or electronic link to the video of the 2021 K9 Unit launch in the Overstrand.
- 5.7. A copy of /or electronic link to all updated safety plans drafted per district.
- 5.8. A breakdown of the Department of Community Safety's role in the LEAP Programme. The breakdown should address updates on the scope of a legislative framework for departmental oversight over the LEAP Programme, criteria for deploying LEAP officers, as well as all departmental reports on the LEAP Programme for the 2021/22 financial year.
- 5.9. A list of the number of high profile investigations currently being conducted by the Western Cape Police Ombudsman.
- 5.10. A list of the accredited NHWs and the list of NHWs with pending accreditation.
- 5.11. A list of the Community Police Forums funded by the Department.
- 5.12. A business plan with the City of Cape Town on the Leap programme, since the inception of the programme.
- 5.13. Cost analysis of the LEAP programme for each financial year since its inception.
