1. Welcome and attendance

The Chairperson opened the meeting and allowed brief introductions by the Minister and the Head of Department.

2. Consideration of Vote 3: Provincial Treasury in the Schedule to the Western Cape Adjustments Appropriation Bill [B 3-2022]

The Minister and Head of Department gave introductory remarks on budgetary adjustments to Vote 3: Provincial Treasury. The Committee proceeded to a discussion on Vote 3, in the Adjusted Estimates of Provincial Expenditure book.

The Committee deliberated and engaged the Department on Vote 3. The Chairperson thanked the Department's officials and the Minister for the preparation and responses to the questions raised by the Committee Members and for their hard work and dedication during the year.

The Chairperson noted that there were no questions or comments raised by members of the public.

The Committee proceeded to express their views on the Vote.

3. Consideration and adoption of the draft Committee Report on Vote 3: Provincial Treasury in the Schedule to the Western Cape Second Adjustments Appropriation Bill [B 3-2022]


The Chairperson submitted the draft Committee Report, which was considered and adopted. In accordance with Standing Rule 90, the African National Congress and Al Jama-Ah expressed its Minority View to not support the Vote.

4. Discussion on the way forward for the Copyright and Performers' Protection Amendment Bills

The Chairperson informed Members that the Committee would commence with the public hearings on the Bills during the Cluster Visit Week. The Chairperson indicated that the locations of the public hearings were informed by the presence of an artistic community.

The Chairperson noted that a list of mainstream and community newspapers, and radio broadcasting media options were sent to Members. The Committee was informed that the adverts would run from the beginning of January 2023, and that the deadline for written submissions would be at the end of February 2023 or the beginning of March 2023. The Members indicated their approval for the way forward as indicated by the Chairperson.
