- 6.2. The number of computer equipment that was procured as per the report including the name of the service provider/s which sourced the computers as well as the total breakdown of the equipment.
- 6.3. The performance assessment plan and the protocol of the Chrysalis program including a list and the deployment of the graduates.
- 6.4. Feedback on the concern raised by Member Pat Lekker during the Adjustments Appropriation discussion.
- 6.5. A list of NGOs which is utilized by the department to source out EPWP volunteers.
