- 6.1.4 Copies of the court ruling documents that were presented to the Provincial Cabinet and Heads of Department bi-annually;
- 6.1.5 A copy of the updated table indicating the representivity and vacancies of senior management; and
- 6.1.6 A list of the 16 areas that were reported as the high-crime areas by the Provincial Data Office.
- 6.2 The Committee RESOLVED to invite the Department of the Premier to brief and update the Committee on the status of Cyber Security and Broadband.
