1. Welcome and apologies

The Chairperson opened the meeting by welcoming all the members, members of the public and presenters to the meeting. No apologies were received. 2. Briefing by the Department of Trade, Industry and Competition

The Chairperson opened the floor for any questions of clarity from the attendees, including any inputs on the briefing by Mr Makgaba. No inputs were raised by the attendees at the meeting.

3. Briefings and inputs provided by the following organisations on the proposed amendments to the aforementioned bills

Mr Aynon Doyle, Head: Policy Analysis & Research at Multichoice provided inputs through a detailed presentation on the proposed amendments of the bills. In addition, Mr Theo Olivier from the ANC also provided verbal inputs on the proposed amendments to the bills.

The Chairperson opened the floor to the members of the public to pose any questions of clarity and to provide any inputs on the proposed amendments of the bills.


4. Resolutions/Actions
