3. Consideration and adoption of the Committee Report on Vote 8: Mobility in the Schedules to the Western Cape Appropriation Bill [B2–2023]

The Chairperson submitted a Draft Report on Vote 8 in the Schedule to the Western Cape Appropriation Bill [B 2–2023], after which the Committee supported the Vote. In accordance with Standing Rule 90, the African National Congress expressed its minority view that it did not support the Vote.

4. Resolutions/Actions

4.1 The Committee REQUESTED that the Department provides the Committee with:

4.1.1 A breakdown of all the fines issued by Provincial Traffic Law Enforcement the past three financial years (total amount of fines issued, total amount of fines recovered and percentage of fines recovered);

4.1.2. Its pedestrian road safety strategy and a report on the implementation of such strategy


4.1.3. A report on the conceptualisation and implementation of a passenger voucher system.

4.2 The Committee RESOLVED to invite the Department to brief the Committee on:

4.2.1 Its plans to address the conflict within the taxi industry and the public transport environment as a whole; and

4.2.2 The application process for taxi operating licenses with specific reference to the number of applications, turnaround time of applications, number and reasons for backlogs and number for applications declined and reasons.
