
4. Resolutions/Actions

4.1 The Committee REQUESTED that the Department provides the Committee with a report on the high-performance vehicles highlighting the following:

- 4.1.1 The number of vehicles that was procured;
- 4.1.2 The total cost of the procurement contract;
- 4.1.3 When were these vehicles procured;
- 4.1.4 When were the first vehicles made available for operations;
- 4.1.5 The number of high-performance vehicles that must still be rolled out;
- 4.1.6 The progress in relation to the roll-out of these vehicles;
- 4.1.7 The reasons for the delayed roll-out; and
- 4.1.8 Whether the warranties or service plans on these vehicles, were affected due to the delayed roll-out?

4.2 The Committee RESOLVED that it would find a suitable date during the first quarter in 2024 to visit Phase 4A of the George Integrated Public Transport Network (Go George).
