MEDIA ALERT: 16 DAYS OF ACTIVISM FOR NO VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND CHILDREN TO BE COMMEMORATED DURING AN ENGAGEMENT IN WORCESTER

On Friday, 22 November, the Western Cape Provincial Parliament (WCPP) will host an event to commemorate the 16 Days of Activism for No Violence Against Women and Children campaign at the Indoor Sports Centre, in Van Huyssteen Avenue, Esselen Park, Worcester. The 16 Days campaign takes place annually from 25 November to 10 December, and during this period specific focus falls on the fostering of collaborative efforts in dealing with gender-based violence.
