#### 1. Opening and welcome

The Chairperson opened the meeting and welcomed the members of the Committee, the Minister, Head of Department, Chairperson of the WESGRO Board, the Chief Executive Officers of WESGRO, SBIDZ and ASEZ, departmental officials, and those who were watching the live proceedings on YouTube.

- 2. Deliberation on Vote 12: Economic development and Tourism in the Schedule to the Western Cape Adjustments Appropriation Bill [B 2–2024]
- 2.1 The Department briefed the Committee on Vote 12 in the Schedule to the Western Cape Adjustments Appropriation Bill [B 2–2024].

The Committee deliberated after which it agreed to support the Vote. The African National Congress and Al Jama-ah did not support the Vote.

- 2.2 The African National Congress provided the following reasons for not supporting the Vote:
- 2.2.1 The Budget Adjustment failed to address the ongoing demands for the Department to prioritise the Informal Economy, where the majority of marginalised communities operate;
- 2.2.2 The Skills Development Programme consistently faced budget reallocations year after year, with R3,4 million being diverted to fund goods and services for other sub-programmes. Of this amount, R2 million was allocated to the Market Intelligence Report of the Western Cape Technology Sector;
- 2.2.3 The R4,6 million reduction in Compensation of Employees highlighted the constrained human resources, which hampered the effective delivery of the Department's mandate, particularly the mandate of the Growth for Jobs Strategy; and
- 2.2.4 The allocation of R20 million to address the cash flow problems experienced by Freeport Saldanha was not supported, as this indicated a potential risk for this Entity under the management of the Department.
- 3. Consideration and adoption of Draft Committee Report on Vote 12: Economic Development and Tourism in the Schedule to the Western Cape Adjustments Appropriation Bill [B 2–2024]

Upon conclusion of its deliberations the Chairperson submitted a Draft Report. The African National Congress and Al Jama-ah requested that their minority view be included in the Report, after which the Report was considered and adopted.

# 4. Closing

The Chairperson expressed his appreciation to the members, the Minister of Agriculture, Economic Development and Tourism, the Head of Department, the Chairperson of the WESGRO Board, the Chief Executive Officers of WESGRO, SBIDZ and ASEZ and departmental officials for their contribution to the success of the meeting. As this was expected to be the last meeting for the calendar year, the Chairperson extended well wishes to all for the festive period.

The meeting adjourned at 15:36.
