- (1) What percentage of firearms handed in during the amnesty period have been destroyed;
- (2) whether any of the firearms handed in were South African Police Service (SAPS) firearms; if so, how many;
- (3) whether any firearms handed in during the amnesty were confiscated; if so, (a) how many and if any (b) how many were SAPS firearms?

- (1) Whether provincial traffic has conducted any operations or integrated road blocks on the N2 between Craggs, Bitou and the Bloukrans Bridge in (i) 2012/13, (ii) 2013/14 and (iii) to date for the current financial year; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;

- (2) whether provincial traffic confiscated any illegal substances from vehicles using the N2 between Plettenberg Bay and the Bloukrans Bridge in the (i) 2012/13 and (ii) 2013/14 financial years; if so, what are the relevant details?

- (1) What measure are being put in place to ensure that the province's water and sanitation infrastructure will not break down in the short-term;
- (2) whether there are any long-term measures to maintain the infrastructure; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?
