1. Briefing by the Western Cape Education Department (WCED) on the National Senior Certificate (NSC) 2015 results

Ms T Singh briefed the Committee on the National Senior Certificate results 2015.

The Committee deliberated on the briefing.

The Committee RESOLVED that: -

- 1.1. The Department avail the results obtained in the Life Science subject.
- 1.2. The Department provide the analysis of the 29 schools that have obtained less than 60% pass rate. The analysis should be in terms of Department, the designation such as, how many former House of Representatives (HOR), former Department of Education and Training (HET) and how many Independent Schools.
- 1.3. The Department provide the targets set by the Circuit Managers for all schools, including the 29 schools that obtain a pass rate lower than 60%.
- 1.4. The Department provide copies of the School Improvement Plans for each of the 29 schools as indicated above.
- 1.5. The Department brief the Committee on the targets set by the Circuit Managers for all schools and the School Improvement Plans for 2016 and that the briefing session be scheduled for 16 February 2016.
