1. Ms A Cassiem: That the House debates the issue of access to land for poor, marginalised and emerging black farmers (African, coloured and Indian) in the Western Cape.
2. Mr T M Klaas: That the House debates issues concerning the insourcing of all security guards, cleaners and general workers who are working for the Western Cape Government's departments and their entities through agencies.
3. Ms A P Bans: That the House debates gun violence and gun-related crimes that are on the rise in the Western Cape.
4. Ms N D Nkondlo: That the House debates the 17,6% power tariff hike in the Western Cape.

5. Ms A P Bans: That the House debates the sudden surge in child murders and kidnapping in Cape Town.
6. Ms N G Bakubaku-Vos: That the House debates Cape Town's new homeless plan, noting that the City of Cape Town has about 14 000 homeless people and the new plan will only make provision for 3 500 beds.
7. Ms R Windvogel: That the House debates the poor service delivery at the Bishop Lavis Community Health Centre and other hospitals and clinics in the Western Cape, including delays in attending to patients, the untidiness of facilities and patients being turned away without medication on their appointment dates.
8. Ms N G Bakubaku-Vos: That the House debates the increasing concern over attacks on social workers as they try to go about their work in certain areas in Cape Town, noting that Emergency Medical Services vehicles have been attacked and that staff members have been hijacked.

KENNISGEWING VAN VOORSTELLE

1. Me A Cassiem: Dat die Huis die kwessie van toegang tot grond vir arm, gemarginaliseerde en ontluikende swart boere (swart, bruin en Indiërs) in die Wes-Kaap debatteer.
2. Mn T M Klaas: Dat die Huis kwessies met betrekking tot die indiensneming van alle sekuriteitswagte, skoonmakers en algemene werkers wat vir die Wes-Kaapse Regering se departemente en hul entiteite deur middel van agentskappe werk, debatteer.
3. Me A P Bans: Dat die Huis wapengeweld en wapenverwante misdaad wat in die Wes-Kaap aan die toeneem is, debatteer.
4. Me N D Nkondlo: Dat die Huis die 17,6%-elektrisiteitstariefverhoging in die Wes-Kaap debatteer.

5. Me A P Bans: Dat die Huis die skielike toename in kindermoorde en -ontvoerings in die Wes-Kaap debatteer.
6. Me N G Bakubaku-Vos: Dat die Huis Kaapstad se nuwe plan vir hawelose mense debatteer, met kennisname dat die Stad Kaapstad ongeveer 14 000 hawelose mense het en dat die nuwe plan net vir 3 500 beddens voorsiening maak.
7. Me R Windvogel: Dat die Huis die slechte dienslewering, insluitende vertragings met die behandeling van pasiënte, die onnetheid van fasilitete en pasiënte wat op hul afspraakdatums sonder medikasie weggewys word, by die Bishop Lavis-gemeenskapsgesondheidsentrum en by ander hospitale en klinieke in die Wes-Kaap debatteer.
