Consideration and Finalisation of Western Cape Provincial Transport Infrastructure Bill [B 5B-2021] (Minister of Infrastructure).

NOTICES OF MOTION (20 April 2023)

1. Mr F C Christians: That the House debates the eradication of pit latrines at schools nationally.

NOTICES OF MOTION (13 April 2023)

1. Mr I M Sileku: That the House welcomes the report of the Acting Public Protector, Kholeka Gcaleka, that has cleared Minister Anton Bredell of any alleged misconduct in the process of submitting a provincial investigation report concerning the George Municipality; and notes that the allegations and subsequent request for an investigation was a frivolous

attempt at political grandstanding by a former Member of this House and that the provincial Department and Minister have been vindicated in acting in the best interest of the people of the George Municipality.

2. Ms N G Bakubaku-Vos: That the House notes and congratulates the work done by the South African Muslim Charitable Trust and other good Samaritans in restoring the dignity of old people in Cape Town, when the DA has failed to do so; notes that these people helped the Kensington Home for the Aged to build a new dementia unit and bought a minibus taxi to transport the elderly to hospital for appointments; and notes that the elderly home has been asking for assistance for the past seven years from the DA-led government and it took strangers to help them restore the dignity of old people.
3. Mr M K Sayed: That the House notes that 14 April 2023 is the closing date for online applications for admissions to schools for the 2024 academic year; notes and supports the growing calls from parents for this date to be extended as many parents are affected by the technical glitches in the Western Cape Education Department's online application system; calls on Minister Maynier to extend the deadline and to roll out online application pop-up tables to avert another crisis of unplaced learners in 2024; and supports the calls by the ANC that #NoChildMustBeLeftBehind.
4. Mr M K Sayed: That the House notes and remembers the words of Former President Nelson Mandela that "We know too well that our freedom is incomplete without the freedom of the Palestinians" and condemns the ongoing apartheid Israeli atrocities against innocent Palestinians, which includes the expansion of illegal settlements and the siege on the Al-Aqsa Mosque; notes that Palestinian self-determination ought to be supported; makes clear demands on the international community to isolate apartheid Israel; calls on the Speaker to light the legislature in the colours of the Palestinian flag; and urges the honourable Members of this House to support the International Quds Day march in solidarity with the Palestinians on Friday 14 April 2023 in Cape Town.
5. Ms A P Bans: That the House notes with deep shock and sadness the brutal murder of six people who were shot by unknown assailants in Ocean View on Wednesday 12 April 2023; further notes police reports that say a vehicle pulled up in front of a house on Neptune Lane in Ocean View at approximately 10:50 and that the occupants of the vehicle went inside the house and started shooting at individuals, where they left five men between the ages of 20 and 50 dead while the sixth person died on arrival at hospital; further notes that the SAPS suspects that the incident could be gang-related; calls on the SAPS to leave no stone unturned in investigating the matter and to bring the perpetrators to book; condemns the DA government for cutting the budget for the LEAP programme while people are dying on the streets due to gang violence; and implores the provincial government to work with the SAPS to find ways to curb this violence in this province.
6. Mr M Kama: That the House notes with pride the successful hosting of various sports tournaments in different communities in the province over the Easter weekend, including rugby and soccer tournaments that attracted thousands of spectators; appreciates that these activities are part of the development of young people and the building of social cohesion in our communities; congratulates the sports federations, sports administrators and small businesses operating in the different communities for making these events a success and presenting such opportunities to the youth at risk – despite not receiving any support and/or funding from the DA government; further notes with disappointment and laments the absence of the Department of Cultural Affairs and Sport and the Minister in the delivery of these events, which shows that this government pays lip service to presenting young

people with alternatives to crime; condemns the Minister's failure to attend the rugby tournament in Khayelitsha, which attracted thousands of spectators, but instead decided to join the Easter rugby and netball tournament for whites in Saldanha; and notes further and accepts that in the hands of this DA government lie the lives of the many talented athletes and soccer players that we lose to drugs in our different communities because of a lack of support and development opportunities aided by government, these include the late Mateketa (Gotsi) from Mbekweni who we lost to tik and many communities can tell stories of lost talents that could have flown the South African flag high in the international arena.

7. Mr C M Dugmore: That the House notes with pride the Employment Equity Bill signed into law by President Cyril Ramaphosa; notes that this bill and its provisions will enable and promote diversity and equality in the workplace and empower the government to set specific equity targets by sector and region, where transformation initiatives have lagged behind; notes that this is also an effort to decrease unemployment as part of ensuring the employment equity objectives become reality; and notes that the law now compels labour inspectors to inspect workplaces and to issue employers with compliance orders.

KENNISGEWING VAN VOORSTELLE (20 April 2023)

1. Mnr F C Christians: Dat die Huis die verwydering van puttoilette by skole nasionaal debatteer.

KENNISGEWING VAN VOORSTELLE (13 April 2023)

1. Mnr I M Sileku: Dat die Huis die verslag van die waarnemende openbare beskermer, Kholeka Gcaleka, verwelkom wat Minister Anton Bredell vrygespreek het van enige beweerde wangedrag in die proses om 'n provinsiale ondersoekverslag oor die George-munisipaliteit in te dien; en kennis neem dat die bewerings en daaropvolgende versoek vir

’n ondersoek ’n ligsinnige poging tot politieke effekbejag deur ’n voormalige Lid van hierdie Huis was en dat die provinsiale Departement en Minister geregverdig was om in die beste belang van die mense van die George-munisipaliteit op te tree.

2. Me N G Bakubaku-Vos: Dat die Huis kennis neem van en die werk aanprys wat deur die Suid-Afrikaanse Moslem-liefdadigheidstrust (“South African Moslem Charitable Trust”) en ander barmhartige samaritane gedoen het om die waardigheid van bejaardes in Kaapstad te herstel, terwyl die DA versuim het om dit te doen; kennis neem dat hierdie mense die Kensington-ouetehuis gehelp het om ’n nuwe demensie-eenheid te bou en ’n minibustaxi gekoop het om bejaardes hospitaal toe te vervoer vir afsprake; en kennis neem dat die ouetehuis die afgelope sewe jaar bystand van die DA-geleide regering gevra het, maar dat dit het vreemdelinge gekos om hulle te help om die waardigheid van die bejaardes te herstel.
3. Mnr M K Sayed: Dat die Huis neem kennis dat 14 April 2023 die sluitingsdatum vir aanlyn aansoeke om toelating tot skole vir die 2024- akademiese jaar is; kennis neem en steun verleen aan toenemende oproepe van ouers dat hierdie datum verleng moet word aangesien baie ouers geraak word deur die tegniese foute in die Wes-Kaapse Onderwysdepartement se aanlynaansoekstelsel; ’n beroep op Minister Maynier doen om die sperdatum te verleng en om aanlynaansoek-opwiptafels te implementeer om nog ’n krisis van ongeplaaste leerders in 2024 te voorkom; en steun verleen aan die ANC se oproep dat #NoChildMustBeLeftBehind.
4. Mnr M K Sayed: Dat die Huis kennis neem van en die woorde van Oudpresident Nelson Mandela onthou dat “Ons weet net te goed dat ons vryheid onvolledig is sonder die vryheid van die Palestyne” en die voortslepende Israeliese apartheidsgruweldade teen onskuldige Palestyne veroordeel, wat die uitbreiding van onwettige nedersettings en die beleg van die Al-Aqsa-moskee insluit; kennis neem dat Palestynse selfbeskikking ondersteun behoort te word; duidelike eise aan die internasionale gemeenskap gestel word om apartheid-Israel te isoleer; ’n beroep op die Speaker doen om die wetgewer in die kleure van die Palestynse vlag te verlig; en die agbare Lede van hierdie Huis versoek om die Internasionale Quds-dag-optog in solidariteit met die Palestyne op Vrydag 14 April 2023 in Kaapstad te ondersteun.
5. Me A P Bans: Dat die Huis met diepe skok en hartseer kennis neem van die wrede moord op ses mense wat op Woensdag 12 April 2023 deur onbekende aanvallers in Ocean View geskiet is; verder kennis neem van polisieverslae wat aandui dat ’n voertuig omstreeks 10:50 voor ’n huis in Neptunelaan in Ocean View gestop het en dat die insittendes van die voertuig die huis binnegegaan het en op individue begin skiet het, en vyf mans tussen die ouderdom van 20 en 50 dood gelaat het terwyl die sesde persoon met aankoms by die hospitaal gesterf het; verder kennis neem dat die SAPD vermoed dat die voorval bende-verwant kan wees; ’n beroep op die SAPD doen om alles in hul vermoë te doen om die saak te ondersoek en om die oortreders aan te kla; die DA-regering veroordeel vir die besnoeiing van die begroting vir die LEAP-program terwyl mense op straat weens bende-geweld sterf; en die provinsiale regering versoek om met die SAPD saam te werk om maniere te vind om hierdie geweld in hierdie provinsie hok te slaan.
6. Mnr M Kama: Dat die Huis met trots kennis neem van die suksesvolle aanbieding van verskeie sporttoernooie in verskillende gemeenskappe in die provinsie oor die Paasaweek, insluitend rugby- en sokkertoernooie wat duisende toeskouers gelok het; erken dat hierdie aktiwiteite deel is van die ontwikkeling van jongmense en die bou van sosiale samehorigheid in ons gemeenskappe; die sportfederasies, sportadministrateurs en

kleinsakeondernemings wat in die verskillende gemeenskappe werksaam is, gelukwens met die sukses van hierdie geleentheid en die aanbieding van sulke geleentheid vir die jeug wat in gevaar is – ten spyte daarvan dat hulle geen ondersteuning en/of befondsing van die DA-regering ontvang het nie; verder met teleurstelling kennis neem en die afwesigheid van die Departement van Kultuursake en Sport en die Minister betreur in die aanbieding van hierdie gebeure, wat bewys dat hierdie regering net lippediens doen om jong mense alternatiewe vir misdaad te bied; die Minister se versuim veroordeel om die rugbytoernooi in Khayelitsha, wat duisende toeskouers gelok het, by te woon, maar eerder besluit het om by die Paasrugby- en netbaltoernooi vir blankes in Saldanha by te woon; en verder kennis neem en aanvaar dat die lewens van talle talentvolle atlete en sokkerspelers in die hande van hierdie DA-regering is, lewens wat in ons verskillende gemeenskappe aan dwelms afgestaan is weens ’n gebrek aan ondersteuning en ontwikkelingsgeleentheid wat deur die regering ondersteun word, insluitende die ontslape Mateketa (Gotsi) van Mbekweni wat aan tik dood is, en baie gemeenskappe kan stories vertel van verlore talente wat die Suid-Afrikaanse vlag hoog in die internasionale arena kon laat wapper het.

7. Mnr C M Dugmore: Dat die Huis met trots kennis neem van die Diensbillikheids-wetsontwerp (“Employment Equity Bill”) wat President Cyril Ramaphosa bekragtig het; kennis neem dat hierdie wetsontwerp en sy bepalinge diversiteit en gelykheid in die werkplek moontlik sal maak en bevorder en die regering sal bemagtig om spesifieke billikheidsteikens volgens sektor en streek te stel, waar transformasie-inisiatiewe agterweë gebly het; kennis neem dat dit ook ’n poging is om werkloosheid te verminder as deel van die proses om toe te sien dat die doelwitte van billike indiensneming ’n werklikheid word; en kennis neem dat die wet arbeidsinspekteurs nou verplig om werkplekke te inspekteer en om voldoeningsbevele aan werkgewers uit te reik.
