Distribution of Food parcels to Beneficiaries

The Cederberg SDA received the following number of Food parcels:

- Total = 1400 (20 food parcels are left for emergency cases)

The officials from DSD and SCAC worked together on the completion of assessments forms for the first applications. The Social workers of Badisa Citrusdal and Clanwilliam assisted with applications from their areas. During the delivery of the food parcels, the organizations in the different areas assisted the team members and everything went well.

The DSD office participated in the JOC Meeting of Cederberg Municipality (06 April 2020) and there was continued collaboration between DSD and the other role players in the different communities.

The Service Provider, Islamic Relief SA, only delivered the food parcels to the Vredenburg Regional office. Staff of the SDA had to collect the parcels with two GG vehicles (Bakkies). After the Team leader approached the Cederberg Municipality, they assisted with the transport of the food parcels from Vredenburg to Clanwilliam.

A good collaborative process was developed between DSD and the NGO's in the areas with regard to the referral and application process, information sharing about assessments and also with the delivery of the food parcels in the different areas. SCAC, Rural Impact and Badisa Citrusdal were the organizations that assisted in terms of making office space, resources and staff available to do the assessments. Cederberg Municipality also supported with the distribution of food parcels in Wuppertal and surrounding farms.

Representatives of DSD, SASSA and Cederberg Municipality worked closely together to prevent double-dipping. We shared and coordinated our different applications and approved lists of beneficiaries. Referrals were done by the Call center, Social workers, NPO's, Municipality, Community and Church leaders, etc.

A total of 1380 food parcels were delivered. Twenty (20) food parcels were reserved as emergency parcels. The names of the beneficiaries who could not receive food parcels were forwarded to the Cederberg Municipality and other organizations that are also distributing food parcels and SASSA.
