With reference to the forensic investigation undertaken by the Special Investigating Unit (SIU) in the Oudtshoorn Municipality that revealed that there were at least 132 transgressions of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA) and various other pieces of legislation during the period that led to the mandatory intervention in terms of section 139 of the MFMA, including two cases of alleged corruption and eight of fraud, what are the relevant details?

How many (a) policing sectors are there in the (i) Western Cape and (ii) City of Cape Town and (b) how many of the sectors in (i) and (ii) are patrolled 24 hours a day, seven days a week, with two VISPOL vans per shifts?

(1) How many vacancies are there in the total staff establishment of the police stations at (a) Manenberg, (b) Lavender Hill, (c) Elsies River, (d) Hanover Park and (e) Lentegeur;

(2) whether there are any plans to fill these vacancies at the police stations in (1); if not, why not; if so, what are the timelines?
