RULES GOVERNING PROCEEDINGS OF THE PROVINCIAL YOUTH PARLIAMENT

A delegate may speak only when he or she has been recognised by the Chair.

Whenever the Chair wants to say something during a debate, any delegate speaking or offering to speak must resume his or her seat, and the Chair must be heard without interruption.

A ruling of the Chair on a point of order raised by a delegate is final.

Only points of order that are of procedural nature are allowed; disputes of facts or trivial points of order are not permitted.

A delegate speaking must address the Chair and not speak directly to other delegates.

Delegates are NOT covered by parliamentary privilege; therefore, they may not defame members of the public or each other.

The use of offensive or derogatory language against other delegates is not allowed.

A delegate who disrupts proceedings or disregards a ruling of the Chair may be ordered to leave the Chamber.

During proceedings, delegates may not converse with each other aloud.

A delegate may not interrupt another delegate whilst speaking, except to raise a point of order.

Delegates must refer to each other in a respectful manner.
